

# Modi Govt strengthened cooperatives movement, extended three times more help to farmers: Shah

LUCKNOW, Feb 23 (PTI)

CLAIMING that his party has strengthened the cooperatives movement in the country, BJP President Amit Shah said on Saturday the Modi Government has extended three times more help to farmers when compared to the previous UPA Government. "The previous UPA Government of Sonia Gandhi and

Manmohan Singh had extended loans worth Rs 23,635 crore to farmers through cooperatives, while the present Modi Government has extended a help of Rs 72,051 crore — which is three times more," Shah said, addressing the Sahakari Sammelan of his party here.

"In five years, the Sonia-Manmohan Government being run with the support of SP and BSP managed this... Can you imagine how much the cooperatives movement has been strengthened in the country (after that)," he asked. The BJP President also took a

dig at the Congress President, saying "Rahul baba makes fun of us, says farmers debt has to be waived. We have done and shown in Uttar Pradesh; you (Congress) had promised in Karnataka that Rs 48,000 crore worth (farm loans) will be waived but could manage only Rs 1,800 crore."

"Why are you misleading farmers by making false promises?" Shah said. "In 10 years of UPA Government Rs 53,000 crore of three crore farmers was waived once. On Sunday, in Gorakhpur, the Prime Minister will launch a scheme which will extend a help of Rs 75,000 crore, benefitting 15 crore farmers in one year, and when 10 years of this (NDA) Government is completed, Rs 7,50,000 crore would have been transferred in the accounts of farmers," he promised.

The foundation of 'change' has been laid by Modi in a manner that he has taken development ahead, he said.

## Vadra moves court seeking copy of case documents from ED

NEW DELHI, Feb 23 (PTI)

ROBERT Vadra, facing Enforcement Directorate probe in cases of money laundering, moved an application in a Delhi court on Saturday, seeking copy of case-related documents with the central agency.

Special judge Arvind Kumar posted the matter for February 25. The application was moved through senior advocate KTS Tuli. Vadra, the brother-in-law of Congress President Rahul Gandhi, appeared before the Enforcement Directorate for questioning on multiple occasions in Delhi and Jaipur.

The money laundering cases being probed by the ED relate to purchase of alleged illegal assets abroad and an alleged land scam in Bikaner, Rajasthan.

The court had on February 16 extended the interim bail granted to Vadra till March 2.

## Nodal police officers appointed in all States, UTs

NEW DELHI, Feb 23 (PTI)

ALL States and Union Territories have appointed nodal police officers to resolve problems of Kashmiris who are being targeted in the aftermath of the Pulwama terror attack, officials said on Saturday.

The Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) has also asked all States to ensure security of Kashmiris who were reportedly attacked in Uttarakhand, Uttar Pradesh, Rajasthan, West Bengal and Jammu city in the last few days.

The Ministry said Central Government is concerned about reports of incidents of assaults and harassment against residents of Jammu and Kashmir, especially students in some parts of country, in the aftermath of Pulwama terror attack, which killed 45 CRPF jawans on February 14.

In this regard, an advisory was issued on February 16 also to all State Governments and Union Territory administrations to take necessary steps to ensure safety and security of the people belonging to Jammu and Kashmir.

## Gadkari to lay foundation stones for seven NH projects in Himachal today

UNION Road Transport Minister Nitin Gadkari will lay foundation stones for seven national highway projects worth over Rs 4,419 crore in Kangra, Himachal Pradesh, on Sunday.

The projects include four-laning of 37.03 km long Punjab-Himachal Pradesh Border to Sihuni section of NH-154 at a cost of Rs 1,572.9 crore and construction of 104.6 km long Paonta Sahib-Guma-Feduzpuz

section of NH-707 at a cost of Rs 1,356 crore as well as 109.45

km long Hamirpur-Mandi section of NH-70 at a cost of Rs 1334 crore. "These projects are likely to benefit the local populace by way of increased tourism, safe journey, reduced travel time, beautification of highways, enhanced economic activity and employment and all-weather roads," an official statement

said. The projects include upgra-

Garshankar-Shri Anandpur Saheb-Naina Devi road at a cost of Rs 581 crore and construction of 2.555 km long elevated structure and vehicular underpass on NH-44 at Phagwara city at a cost of Rs 165 crore. ## FROM THE FRONT PAGE Situation between India and Pak is very bad, dangerous: Trump

Responding to questions on the tense situation between the two South Asian neighbours, Trump said the US is talking about it so does some other nations, without mentioning them. "We are talking and a lot of people are talking. But, it is a very, very delicate balance going on right now. There's a lot of problems between India and Pakistan because of what just happened," said the US President. "We're very much involved in that, if that's what you're referring to," he said. Trump described the current situation between India and Pakistan as very dangerous.

"It's a terrible thing going on right now between Pakistan and India... It is a very, very bad situation and it's a very dangerous situation between the two countries. We would like to see it stopped. A lot of people were just killed and we want to see it stopped," he said.

Trump claimed that his administration has developed a much better relationship with Pakistan, even after he stopped USD 1.3 billion in financial aid to Islamabad.

"I stopped Pakistan, the USD 1.3 billion that we were paying

them. In the meantime, we may set up some meetings with Pakistan. "Pakistan was taking very strong advantage of the United States under other Presidents and we were paying Pakistan 1.3 billion a year. I ended that payment to Pakistan because they weren't helping us in a way that they should have. And honestly, we've developed a much better relationship with Pakistan over the last short period of time than we had," Trump said.

In the wake of the Pulwama attack, US National Security Adviser John Bolton told his Indian counterpart Ajit Doval last week that America supports India's right to self-defence as both sides vowed to work together to ensure that Pakistan ceases to be a safe haven for JeM and other terror groups.

India has asked Pakistan to take immediate and verifiable action against terrorists and terror groups operating from territories under its control.

New Delhi also announced the withdrawal of the Most Favoured Nation status for Pakistan and hiked the customs duty by 200 per cent on goods originating from Pakistan.

## 13 killed in UP shop explosion

Locals claimed that Mansoori was also in the business of making illegal firecrackers. The invitation to India by the OIC comes at a time when India has been mounting diplomatic offensive against Pakistan to isolate it internationally following the Pulwama terror attack in which 45 CRPF personnel were killed.

The OIC has usually been supportive of Pakistan and, often sided with Islamabad on the Kashmir issue.

The MEA said Foreign Minister of United Arab Emirates Sheikh Abdullah bin Zayed Al Nahyan invited Swaraj as the 'guest of honour' to address the inaugural plenary and that India was happy to accept the invitation.

"We see this invitation as the desire of the enlightened leadership of the UAE to go beyond our rapidly growing close bilateral ties and forge a true multifaceted partnership at the multilateral and international level," the MEA said in a release.

"We see this invitation as a milestone in our comprehensive strategic partnership with the UAE. We also see this invitation as a welcome recognition of the presence of 185 million Muslims in India and of their contribution to its pluralistic ethos, and of India's contribution to the Islamic world," it said.

India is, therefore, happy to accept the invitation and thanked the leadership of the UAE for it, the Ministry said. OIC is a grouping of 57 countries, majority of which are Muslim majority.

Last year, Bangladesh proposed restructuring of the charter of the Organisation of Islamic Cooperation to pave way for the inclusion of non-Muslim countries like India as an "observer state" of the 50-year old grouping.

## Abducted 5-yr-old twin brothers found dead; cops deny report

## Govt launches crackdown on separatists, arrests 150

Orders issued by some government departments added to the fears of the people. The Government Medical College in Srinagar cancelled winter vacation of its faculty members and directed them to positively report for work on Monday.

The Department of Food, Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs, which provides ration to people through its outlets, has directed its staff members in south Srinagar to ensure completing sale of food grains in their respective areas by Saturday evening. They were also directed to keep ration depots and sale outlets open on Sunday as well.

Markets in Lal Chowk, the commercial hub of the valley, and adjoining areas opened more than an hour late as business owners were not sure of the situation in the wake of detention of over 150 separatist and Jamaat cadres during the night on Friday.

The sound of frequent flying of fighter jets till 1.30 am on Saturday added to the worries of the residents due to simmering Indo-Pak tension following the Pulwama suicide car bomb attack that left 45 CRPF soldiers dead on February 14.

However, IAF officials described it as a routine exercise. Long queues were seen outside petrol stations and people were thronging provision shops and buying essential supplies. The Jamaat issued a statement condemning the detentions and said "...The move is a well-designed conspiracy to pave way for further uncertainty in the region."

The party claimed that during the intervening night of February 22 and 23, police and other agencies launched a mass arrest drive and raided many houses in the valley, wherein dozens of its central and district-level leaders were arrested, including its ameer (chief) Abdul Hamid Fayaz and spokesperson, advocate Zahid Ali.

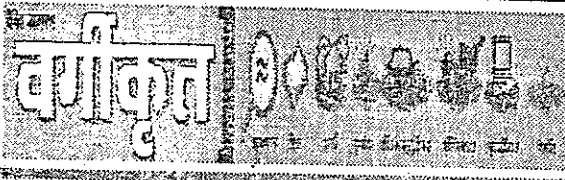
